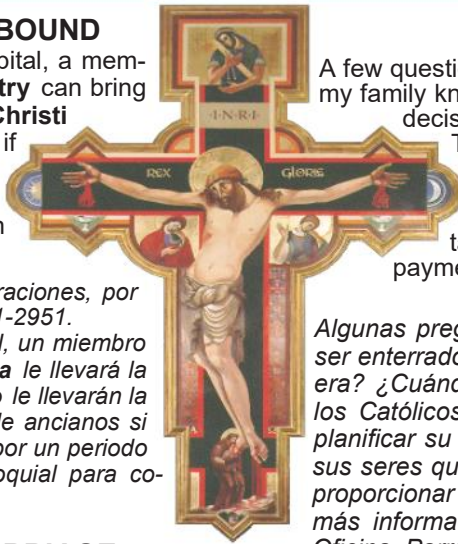


EUCHARIST FOR SICK OR HOME BOUND
